-- Oxnard, Calif. clinic brings quality healthcare to Ventura County veterans; 2nd facility in Calif. --

Washington, D.C. – Valor Healthcare today announced the Grand Opening of a state-of-the-art VA Community-Based Outpatient Clinic located in Oxnard, Calif.

With this announcement, Valor now operates 15 clinics across the country. The Oxnard clinic is the company's second in California, joining another clinic in Laguna Hills. In conjunction with the VA Greater Los Angeles Healthcare System, Valor brings high quality healthcare in a more convenient setting to veterans in Ventura County.

The Oxnard clinic offers primary health services, including women’s health services, lab work and X-rays, and mental health services. With its national industry reputation as a top-quality medical provider, Valor customizes the design of each facility to meet veterans’ health needs, including Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).

“The Oxnard clinic speaks directly to Valor’s mission to provide superior healthcare for our nation’s heroes,” says Dr. Ray Lanier, Valor Healthcare Founder and President. “With patient comfort and privacy as top priorities, our clinics feel similar to a private physician’s office, but are enhanced by wider hallways, enclosed areas for individual check-in, and specialty health clinics for female veterans.”
